


Eritrea Participating in the 59th Session of the UN Commission on the Status of Women (CSW)


Colluli: A World-Class, Low-Cost Potassium Project in Eritrea

Colluli Project is one of the several modern mining projects underway in Eritrea. The Colluli deposit is located in the eastern part of the country, approximately 350km south of Asmara and 180km from the port of Massawa.



The resource contains over 1.2 billion tonnes of potassium bearing salts suitable for the production of potash fertilizers, and is only 75km from the Red Sea coast making it one of the most accessible potash deposits in the world.
