



Migration Flows Europe: Arrivals and Fatalities



Main nationalities to Greece




Main nationalities to Italy




Arrival points through Europe (24 to 30 March 2016)

Known causes of death 2016

Mediterranean

- **5** Asphyxiation

- 2 Respiratory problem

Remaining deaths are drowning and presumed drowning


