

Some Highlights on NAECA's Megabit 8 Event.

The North American Eritrean Community Association (NAECA), Asmara, celebrated International Women's Day on Megabit 6, 2010. The Chairman of NAECA, Tedros Andemariam, addressed the attendees and discussed the goals of the Association. He explained that the Association is dedicated to give service— assist, consult, refer and expedite — on the needs of its members; as well as, participate on nation building projects. At present, some of these projects include renovation of the Shi'b Cemetery, planting and caring of a section in the Asmara Park Semaetat (Martyrs), promoting internal tourism ...etc. He concluded by declaring that all members stand ready alongside their brothers and sisters within Eritrea and in the Diaspora to defeat all challenges presented by the Unjust Resolution 1907.
