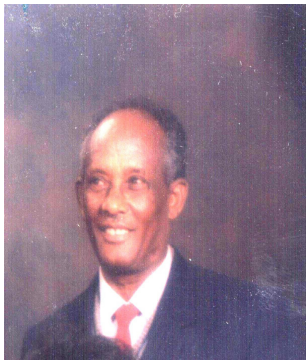

A Brief Life History

Mr. Gebremeskel Deri was born unto the union of his father, Deri Sultan, and his mother, Altash Zeru, on March 3, 1934 in the town of

Agordat, Barka Province, Eritrea.

Our brother, father, and grandfather, “Aya” Gebremeskel Deri was energetic and full of life. He was family-loving and a very friendly human being. Even though he was born in Agordat, he spent considerable time traveling and visiting extended family members and relatives in his ancestral villages of Ad-Teklezan and Adi-Neamen.

When he reached family rearing age, he was joined in holy matrimony with Ms. Muluጥ Yegin. He lived in Tekombia, Gash-Setit province, for a period of 22 years with his eight children and his sister, Hana HaileMichael. He was mainly engaged in Agriculture, plumbing, and trade.

In 1978, because of the oppressive and inhumane conditions under the then Ethiopian administration that resulted in the burning and destruction of their home by aerial bombardment, the entire family was forced to flee to Sudan. Because his wife had passed away before they fled to Sudan, his sister, Hana, served as a surrogate mother to his children.

After a period of five years in Sudan, the family migrated to the United States and arrived in Los Angeles in 1982. In Los Angeles, he was very active in Eritrean community and mass organizations, especially between 1982 and 1989. For many years, he served Medhanie Alem Orthodox Church diligently and with utmost dedication.

He was blessed and fortunate to witness the marriages of his children and birth of his 14 grandchildren. In 1998, he married Mrs. Kidisti Haileyesus and they shared many years of love and warmth together until his passing.

After a brief hospitalization, he passed away at Brotman Hospital on Monday, May 23, 2011.
