450 to 500 Eritrean nationals from San Jose and its environs celebrated the gift of their martyrs, the Independence day, in a colorful manner which brought together the old, the young, the men and women in a national cause, defending and celebrating the identity and the unity of all of us, Eritreans. Just like any other city, at home or abroad where Eritreans live, this year's celebration was different in its characters, as someone had observed it, reminiscent of the first celebration that we had observed in 1992. the mood of the rejection of the UNfair and UNjust sanction against Eritrean people, was as high as one can wish. A Tigrigna poem, related to the current theme of Mekete, "bisraH nmikit, nigisgis" "Through Work, we shall overcome and Progress" was read by an Eritrean citizen that brought light to the meaning of the celebration, the related multidisciplinary development of the country, and the enviable harmony of its citizens.

The joy, hope, and pride of Eritreans in this celebration could be read from their faces that says it all. We all owe our happiness and celebration to our people in general and to our selfless martyrs, war disabled citizens, our defense forces and leaders in particular who sacrificed their life, time, energy and resources. While the celebration of our gift from our martyrs was going in full swing, our Mekete in thwarting the UNjust and UNfair sanction was going side by side. Our Mekete Group from San Jose and its environs, in coordination with YPFDJ members from San Jose were organizing the letter writing drive of the participants by collecting letters to send it directly to President Obama, reminding him about the continued injustice imposed by American led "International Community", and telling him that illegally and unjustifiably sanctioning Eritrea, for its Independence stand, will not bring about any change in Somalia, and that the UNfair sanction must be lifted. Indeed, it was a day of joy and happiness that would further solidify the pledge in defending Eritrea and its people for there would be no dignity without identity.
