Last Sunday, June 19, 2011, Eritreans in San Jose and environs commemorated Eritrean Martyrs Day with great enthusiasm and youth transformation in the recognition of the cause and in solidifying our unity and strengthening of our identity.



The commemoration started out with a minute of silence, followed by singing our National Anthem which the youth, along parents, took part.

The event ended with a minute of silence, following a candle light vigil, in walking around the school campus, three times, after paying respect to the Martyrs' pictures displayed.
