The Eritrean Professionals Network in UK (EriPN) has successfully concluded its 3rd Annual General Meeting organised as part of the 21st Eritrean Independence Anniversary celebrations. The Eritrean Professionals Network was formed in March 2009.

There were interesting discussion and have agreed a clear way forward to implement an action plan. H.E. Mr Tesfamichael Gerahtu Ambassador of State of Eritrea in UK also gave a closing remark and encouraged EriPN to upgrade its efforts to mobilize more members and set up other sectors on economic and management, social and education, health and development.

EriPN has ended its AGM by stating that it will continue to raise its visibility among various social and professional groups and the Eritrean community at large. It will strengthen its work in establishing strong links with Eritrean Departments and professional associations.
