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The Prism of Our Eritrean Diasphora Conversations <u>And</u>

Its Bearing on Our Patriotism



"Developed in 2008 by Brian Solis, The Conversation Prism is a visual map of the social media landscape. It's an ongoing study in digital ethnography that tracks dominant and promising social networks and organizes them by how they're used in everyday life.

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Reading Instruction:

This paper has two parts. Part one is in English and Part two in Tigrigna. The bottom line message of the two parts is identical but the style of each composition is slightly different. The English version is intended to include to those who are not fluent in Tigrigna. It is not word to word translation; however, it could help to get the point across. The Tigrigna version contains with more amplifications.

Part One in English

I have already mentioned the possibility that the Eritrean Moslem to Christians demographic ratio might have already changed from the 50/50 to perhaps 60/40 infavour of the Moslems. The major factor that may have contributed to skewing the pie chart, perhaps, to 60/40 Moslems to Christians ratio could be due to the Christians are migrating out of the coutry in droves while the Moslems are intact. Nevertheless, from the ethno-lingustic demographic perspective the Tigrigna ethnic stands solid and will remain as the overwhelming majority. All the ethno ligustic groups are found listed following the next three paragraphs.

One distinctive information portrayed bellow is about the Moslem Jeberti. It is not included in the ethno-lingustic index while the Rashada is. The truth cannot be other than it is being included with the Tigrigna. 

<u>Eritrea</u> has an estimated population of 5.7 million as of 2010. No reliable census data is available, the best available estimates being published by the Population Division of the <u>United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs</u>.

Population has doubled over the past 30 years, with an accelerating growth rate estimated at close to 3.2% p.a. during 2005–2010. This rate of population growth is sustained despite a high emigration rate; the World Bank as of 2010 estimated that close to a million of Eritreans have emigrated. [1]

The nation has nine recognized ethnic groups. According to <u>SIL Ethnologue</u>, the <u>Tigrinya people</u> make up about 50% of the population; the <u>Tigre</u>, who also speak a <u>Ethiopic</u> language, constitute around 30% of residents. Most of the rest of the population belong to other <u>Afro-Asiatic</u>-speaking communities of the <u>Cushitic</u> branch. Additionally, there are a number of <u>Arabic</u>, <u>Nilo-Saharan</u> and <u>Italian</u>-speaking ethnic minorities.

A majority of Eritrea's population adheres to <u>Abrahamic religions</u>. The two most followed religions are <u>Christianity</u> and <u>Islam</u>, which have an almost equal number of followers.

This topic has been in the spotlight since the demise of Jebha. Much has been said about it but to no avail. This video depicts effectively more than my words could accommodate.


The video is not on one clip only. Have patience to respect it watching one after another to its end and the succeeding part of it. >>> <u>Mujahiden</u>




2. Some Highpoints about the Awrajanet
