G7 Summit protest on Saturday 12 2021

The Ethiopian and Eritrean communities in UK are deeply disturbed and extremely shocked by the most heinous crimes and treasonous act perpetrated by the infamous TPLF leadership against the peoples of Ethiopia generally and the Tigray people in particular and the people of Eritrea. It is equally shocking and perplexing to see the extent to which the USA administration and European Union would like to go in order to absolve the TPLF from their crimes and treacherous deeds.

By ethnic profiling the Ethiopian Federal army, the TPLF fanatic soldiers killed in cold blood their comrade in arms that are of different ethnic group.
