Ethiopian Inaugurates Transformed Addis Ababa Domestic Terminal, Doubling Its Capacity

Addis Ababa, May 18, 2024

The 50 million USD expansion and renovation project has significantly upgraded the terminal, expanding its total built-up area by more than twofold to 25,750 m² and increasing its handling capacity to twofold.

The expanded terminal features modern airport systems and facilities including four contact gates, 10 remote departure gates, 22 check in counters with automated hold baggage screening system, self-check in kiosks, modern security screening system, Premier passengers' lounge and a multitude of various airport facilities
